- 0800 hrs** Start ‘Sail in Company’ from Melbourne and Geelong (separate details to be supplied)  
Registration opens at Queenscliff Harbour.
- 1130 hrs** Race briefing including distribution of Sailing Instructions in Queenscliff Harbour Basin in front of  
Harbour office/boatyard  
Race entry \$20.00 per boat (Block entry fee for SSCBC boats met by club)
- 1145 hrs** lunch (for pre-registered boats – see Booking Form) Fish Fry/BBQ in front of Harbour office building

# QUEENSLIFF MARITIME WEEKEND 2014

Queenscliff has a long association with the sea. The Queenscliffe Maritime Weekend involves local organisations, visitors and friends in celebrating this history and interaction with the sea. Taming the sea has always required teamwork and co-operation. The organisers wish to thank all who have worked and will continue to develop such teamwork and co-operation.

## NOTICE OF RACE

The Queenscliffe Regatta 29 – 30 March 2014

The organising authorities are Couta Boat Association, Sorrento Sailing Couta Boat Association, Queenscliffe Lonsdale Yacht Club Inc.

1. **RULES** – The race will be governed by the rules as defined in ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2014
2. **ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY** - The event is open to registered entrants who agree to comply with the decisions of the race committee and:
  - a. The owner must be a member of a Yachting Australia affiliated club
  - b. The boat must have a current certificate of safety lodged with the owner's home club
  - c. The boat must be insured with current third party liability insurance of not less than \$10 million

### DATES OF RACING

**Saturday 29 March 2014** (Incorporating SSCBC Aggregate Points Race and Race 4 of the Loquat State Couta Boat Championship)

**Sunday 30 March 2014.** (Incorporating SSCBC Aggregate Points Race and Race 5 of the Loquat State Couta Boat Championship)

3. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** – The sailing instructions will only be available at 1130 hrs Queenscliff Harbour, Basin near Harbour office/boatyard (see attached harbour map.) Course and local issues race briefing to be held 1130 hrs on Saturday 28 March at Queenscliff Harbour, Basin near Harbour Office/boatyard. Crew lists must be submitted at this time. Racing will not commence if in the opinion of the race committee wind gusts are in excess of 25 knots, or if a gale warning is issued on the race day prior to the commencement of racing.
4. **VENUE** – Approximately East of Queenscliff Harbour and incorporating at least one inshore mark.
5. **COURSE** – as per sailing instructions.
6. **SCORING** – The 'low point system' will be used.
7. **HANDICAPPING** – Handicaps will be determined by designated handicappers (CYAA, SSCBC, QLYC). Allocated handicaps for other boats will be advised at race briefing.
8. **DIVISIONS** – Subject to at least three boats in each division and otherwise subject to entries received:
  - Classic Yachts – designed before 1970 and constructed of traditional material
  - Couta Boats – Division 1 (CBA)
  - Couta Boats - Division 2 (CBA)
  - Trailables (PHC)
  - Other Keel boats (PHC)
9. **ENTRY** – the entrant must complete, sign and submit by the due date the attached **Registration Form** along with all applicable fees to Mr Phil Hall, Sorrento Sailing Couta Boat Club, [Administration@sscbc.com.au](mailto:Administration@sscbc.com.au)

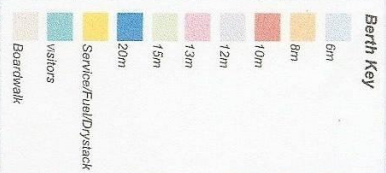
